

TIPS FOR RECYCLING YOUR PACKAGING

Check with your recycling provider for a complete list of acceptable materials and best practices.



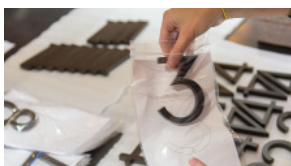
Cardboard : Recycle or Repurpose

- Our boxes are made with recycled content
- You can recycle or compost any of our mailing boxes, including USPS boxes
- Remove stickers and packing tape
- If in good condition, keep and repurpose your box



Paper : Recycle or Repurpose

- Packing paper is made from a high percentage of recycled content
- All the paper inside your box can be recycled - packing slip, notes, packing paper, etc
- Remove any stickers and tape
- Repurpose the packing paper for another use, or as wrapping paper
- Any ink-free paper can be composted



Plastic Bags : Repurpose

- Plastic bags in your shipment cannot be recycled
- Keep and repurpose them
- Handy for organizing and keeping track of smaller items



Padded Envelopes : Recycle or Repurpose

- Our mailing envelopes are made from recycled content
- Can be recycled, or reused if in good condition
- Remove any tape and stickers before recycling



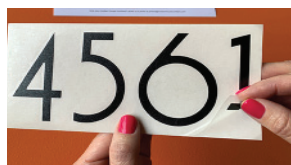
Extra Aluminum Spacers : Recycle

- Made from recycled aluminum
- Extra aluminum spacers can be recycled in your curbside bin
- Once you're finished installing, if you have *extra* spacers, recycle them



Stickers & Tape : Toss

- Stickers and tape cannot be recycled or composted.
- Remove both before recycling or composting cardboard, envelopes or packing paper



Vinyl Decals: Front & Back Film : Toss

- The front and back protective layers on our mailbox and curb decals are not recyclable
